



**Information pursuant to art. 13 of European Regulation concerning the processing of personal data
(GDPR – Reg. U.E. 679/16)**

Pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation UE 679/16 we hereby provide the following information concerning log-in activities on the video surveillance systems.

1) DATA CONTROLLER

Data controller is RONDA Spa, located in Via Vegri 83, 36010 ZANÈ (VI), Italy which shall be contacted at e-mail address info@ronda.it.

2) PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

The data will be processed in order to pursue the legitimate interest of the data processor in protecting the company assets and adopting measures to concretely prevent criminal acts and avoid significant incidents for all those who enter them and for organisational and production needs.

3) MANDATORY NATURE FOR THE PROVISION AND DATA PROCESSED

The provision of data will be mandatory and therefore any refusal to provide them in whole or in part may result in the impossibility for the company to allow access to the establishment. Data controller will collect and process your personal data relating to the following categories:

1. Live and recorded images

4) DATA PROCESSING ' METHODS

The personal data collected will be processed by data controller's staff who will act on the basis of specific instructions provided in relation to the purposes and methods of the processing itself. The processing will be carried out in any case in compliance with the methods and requirements of the data provided for by art. 5 of the GDPR or will be based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of the confidentiality and rights of the interested party; it will include all the operations provided for by art. 4 paragraph 1, no.2, of said GDPR, necessary for processing in question. The processing will be managed with the support of paper and computer means by external parties who have been designated as data processors pursuant to art. 28 of EU Reg. No. 2016/679.

5) DATA RETENTION PERIOD

The data will be retained for 72 hours except for any periods related to holidays, closure, or due to specific investigative requests from law enforcement and/or the Authority, and will be automatically deleted at the conclusion of the prescribed retention period.

6) RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT AND CONSEQUENCES OF NON-DELIVERY

The person concerned has the faculty of exercise the right to ask the data controller to access, correct or delete personal data, or to ask for a processing restriction that relates to his and to oppose the same processing, besides the right of data portability. The person concerned shall exercise his rights by the mentioned contact details.



The person concerned has also the faculty of contacting the controlling Authority in order to lodge a complaint, the Italian data protection body competent is the Garante (www.garanteprivacy.it).

7) COMMUNICATION

The data may be communicated to entities to which communication is required by law.

8) DIFFUSION

Personal data relating to the processing in question will not be disclosed to third parties, except where there are legal obligations to do so.
